20th- 22nd NOVEMBER 2009 – Franzosenweier Forest

The time is nigh and less than a week-ish away from the Swiss Hash event of the year. The following details should get you there, allow you to enjoy the 'delights' of Zürich (Dietikon) and hopefully get you back in one piece (with a few less brain cells...)

**Registration starts 16:00, Friday 20th November
(Red Dress Run starts ~19:30)**

Location: The accommodation is in a self-contained, purpose-built 5* scout/ hashing building on the edge of Dietikon's Franzosenweier Forest – **Pfadihuus Dietike, am Chüestelliweg, 8953 Dietikon**

How to get there?

Driving: There is public parking at the Stadthalle (see first map) approximately 1 minute walk from the venue (just off Fondlistrasse).

To get there drive to central Dietikon and head via Zentralstrasse to Badenerstrasse. Turn left at Steinmürtlistrasse and immediately right on to Studackerstrasse. The Stadthalle should be sign-posted.

Public Transport (Smart choice): Get yourself to the Zürich Main Train Station (Hauptbahnhof, HB) and from platforms 21/22 take Train numbers 3 or 12 to Dietikon (every 16 minutes). From the main station either walk (~15 minutes) to the bus stop at Stadthalle Ost. (Bus no. 306) where there will be flour to the venue (or follow the map) or for the lazy b*rstards (or those of you carrying the kitchen sink....mainly Harrietts) you can get a bus no. 306 from the main station that leaves every 15 minutes (last stop Stadthalle Ost.).

What should you bring?

Bedding: the venue provides a mattress cover, a pillow with cover and a scratchy wool blanket. Mismanagement recommends bringing a sleeping bag or duvet/comforter.

Costume(s): A **RED DRESS** for the Friday Run. The Saturday Party theme is a **BAD TASTE PARTY** so dress appropriately...

NB: There is a swimming pool 2 minutes away so the 'generous' ZH3 team are including a free pass for each hasher to visit the pool (once) either on Saturday before dinner or Sunday morning before the hangover R*n....so bring your SWIMMING GEAR!!

Other things to bring: A flashlight (torch), you never know what may be lurking in the forest! A beer mug (plastic cups will be provided), a towel, toiletries, warm clothes for the Saturday Bonfire & Barbecue and most importantly **house shoes to wear indoors!**
